Tuition Discounts- Active Duty/Retired Military 10%; First Responder \$1,000; Single Parent 10%; Siblings 25%; and Airline Employee 10%

Financial Obligation- The cost of operating the Academy must be budgeted on an annual basis. For this reason, cadets are accepted for the entire school year, and upon entrance, a valid and binding contract is in force for the entire school year. Additionally, because the Academy's budget is tuition-driven, payments are required in a timely fashion. Any payment not received in the Academy's office or through FACTS by the date due, will be charged a \$30.00 late fee. As stated in the contract, should any amount become delinquent, grades and transcripts will be held until the account is settled. Delinquent accounts may be forwarded to an outside agency for collection. Failure to make payments by the due date may result in a cadet's removal from the school.

Tuition includes:

- High school curriculum advisement and SAT/ACT Prep (see our Curriculum Guide)
- Comprehensive college guidance program including assistance with applications and scholarships
- Small class sizes with incredibly dedicated faculty who contribute to learning environments where individual attention is provided
- Discussion-oriented classes with opportunities to speak, understand, read, and write in English
- Individual student Chromebooks and use of wireless campus Internet
- Athletic Program offerings (personal effects such as cleats, mouthguards, and more will need to be provided by the parent, depending on the sport)
- Textbooks and other educational resources
- Unlimited access to academy photos that are all available for download
- Remarkable academic outcomes and acceptance to top-choice universities
- All meals included, excluding snacks purchased at the Canteen (snack bar) or athletic events
- Health Insurance- provided by Southern Prep
- I-20 Form to study in the United States
- Room and board at an AISA Accredited boarding school

- Debit Card, used for snacks at athletic events, Canteen (snack bar), and field trip spending money. This card will be securely stored in our Military Department when not in use
