

UNAUTHORIZED ITEMS

For the safety and well-being of our academy, the following items are strictly unauthorized:

Electronics

Alexa-type devices

Home and Utility

- No TV over 32 inches
- Extension cords, multi-plugs, or outlet multipliers
- Candles and wax warmers
- Tools of any kind (screwdrivers, wrenches, etc.)
- Floss picks
- Lighters

Other Prohibited Items

- Aerosol containers/cans of any type
- Ammunition
- Bicycles
- Civilian clothes
- Knives of any kind
- Darts and dartboard
- DVDs with inappropriate themes (R-rated, sexually explicit content, etc.)
- Firearms of any type, real or imitation
- Fireworks or explosives of any type

Food and Beverage

- Energy drinks
- Pre-workout powder
- Chewing gum
- Sunflower seeds
- Alcohol, alcoholic beverages or mixtures of any type, including mouthwash with alcohol

Appliances and Cookware

- Electrical appliances (coffee pots, Keurigs, hot water kettle/hot pots, hair dryers, corn poppers, electric skillets, microwave ovens, electric heating spoons, waffle maker, electric blankets, air fryers, etc.)
- Glass jugs
- Portable air conditioners or heaters

Drug and Alcohol Paraphernalia

- Display items relating to alcohol, drugs, occult, death, etc.
- Drugs and related paraphernalia (syringes, needles, pipes, inhaling devices, rolling papers, etc.)
- Vapes or vape paraphernalia
- THC pens, edibles, or gummies
- THC paraphernalia
- All Tobacco and Nicotine products, including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, Zyns, and chewing tobacco.

OTHER ITEMS

Additionally, certain items are allowed only with earned privilege; or must be held in the office of the student's Residential Director or Coach when not in use.

Authorized, Must be Turned into RD/Coach

- Video gaming systems, including disks and accessories
- Baseball bats
- Golf clubs
- Airsoft guns and equipment
- Paintball guns and equipment
- Bows & arrows

Authorized, with Permission or Earned Privilege

- Mini-fridge: seniors or students who hold the position of platoon leader or higher. <u>Please</u> <u>check with the Commandant before bringing to</u> <u>campus.</u>
- Personal vehicles: any student with a driver's license. <u>Please contact the Parent Coordinator</u> for permission slip and required paperwork.
- Personal laptops/iPads: students must have endorsement from staff member and complete required paperwork with the Parent Coordinator.
